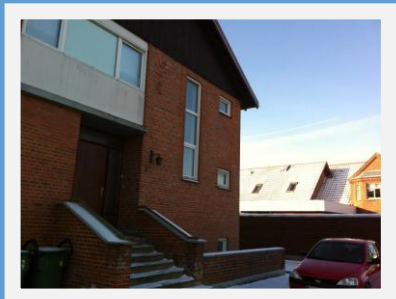

The new timetables will operate from Monday 30th January 2012.

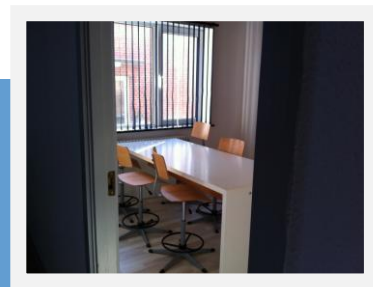
Examinations

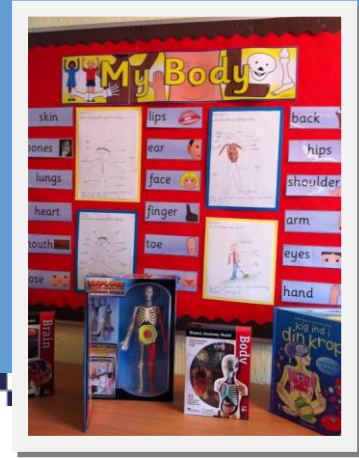
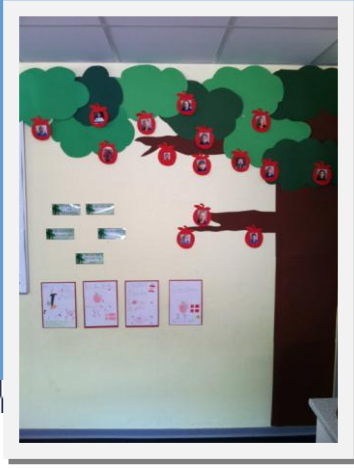
